

Global IT Challenge For Youth with Disabilities 25 - 29 November 2019, Busan, Korea

Guidelines for applicants

1. Type of disabilities (Vision, Hearing, Development, Physical) recognized by the association and Youth with disabilities at the age of 14~22 based on the application date. (University or graduated students are NOT allowed)
2. Persons who completed eLearning education with excellent results.
(Should be able to work with MS-Office, Internet Explorer web browser, Movie Maker and Scratch program)
3. Persons who can communicate and participate in contents in English
4. Other participation and award regulations
 - 1) The Youth who never took an award of GITC can participate in GITC even though they join GITC second time.
 - 2) For individual competition, Best winners are eligible to participate only, but except for all awards in the same event.
 - 3) The Youth who took an award of 'Excellence, Good' on individual competition can only take superior awards.
 - 4) For group competition, if any member has experience Best award with same competition, that group can't take Best award.
 - 5) For group competition, the group doesn't include 4 type of disabilities, they can participate in any competition but they can't take an award. (For group competition, Group need to be composed by 4 type of the Youth with disabilities for awarding)

* 4 type of disabilities : Vision, Hearing, Development, Physical
